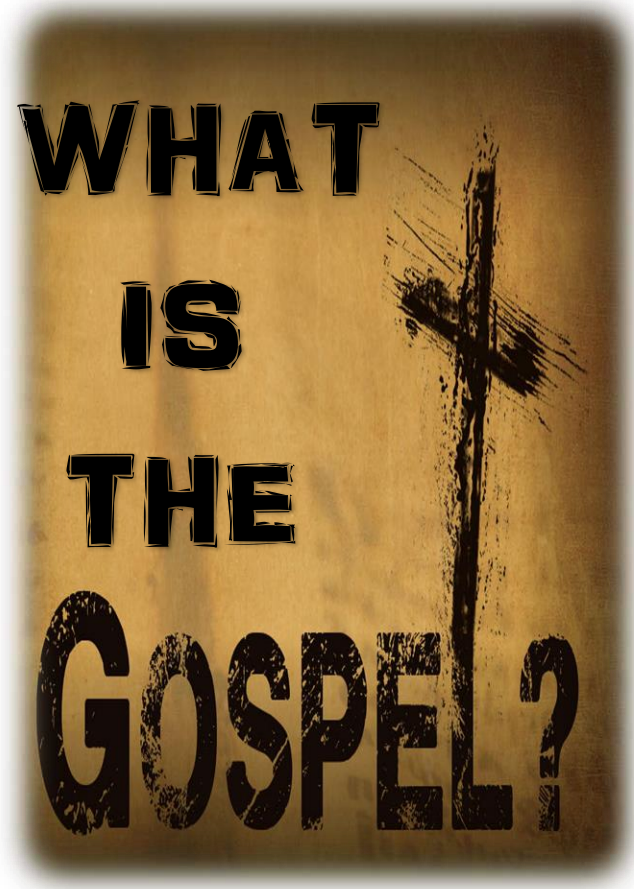
The curly, hard sticks
