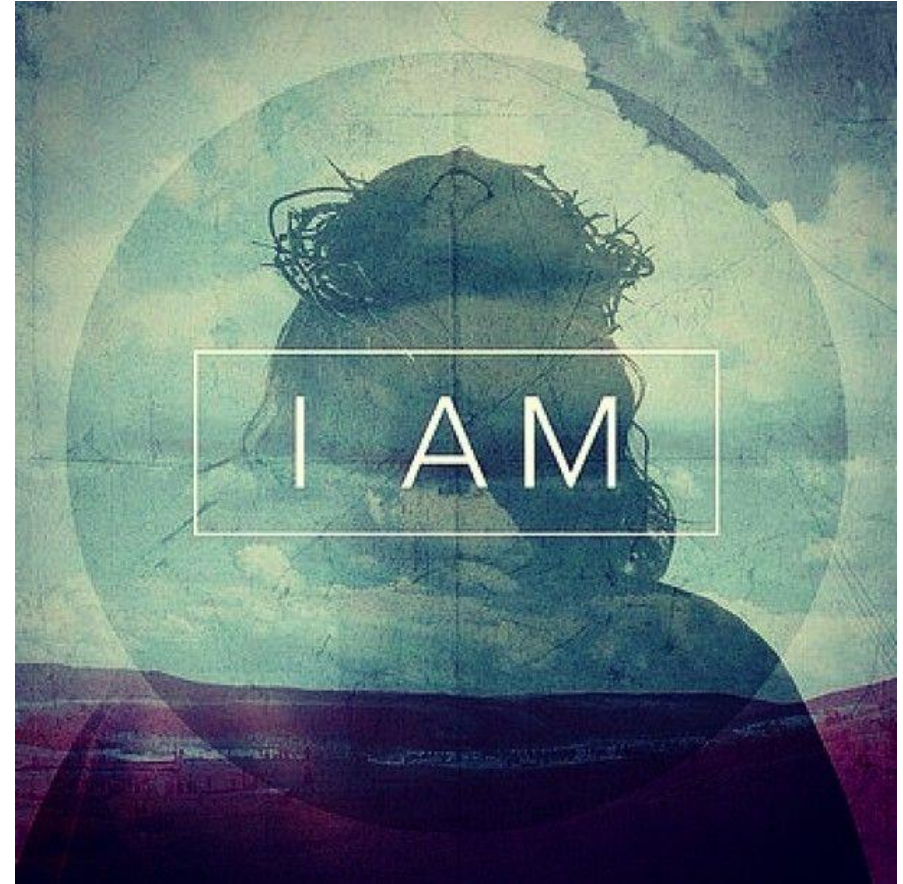
May is National Foster Care Month.
