OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD PACIFIC ISLANDS INITIATIVE:

Samaritan's Purse plans to deliver shoebox gifts to 1,000 Pacific Islands in the next five years. A quote from Franklin Graham *"Here in the pacific, people have very little hope. These are poor areas. We are going island to island to island taking the gospel of Jesus Christ."*

In Saipan alone, there have been 70 shoebox gift distributions, earlier this year, reaching roughly 12,000 children with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The Marshall Islands followed with 25,000 gifts distributed and the Graham family helped deliver 30,000 to the nation of Kiribati.
