Operation Christmas Child has worked among 107 Unreached People Groups in 46 countries in 2018. More than 86,000 unreached children enrolled in The Greatest Journey in 2018 and churches are starting where none were before. In 2019 they partnered with Seed Company, an affiliate of Wycliffe Bible Translators, on translation projects for unreached peoples in Namibia and Burkina Faso. They recently met with Seed Company to explore opportunities to share the Gospel with more unreached people groups. Together they identified 11 groups they want to reach. Please be in prayer for these people groups and the plans that are being made to reach them.
