Winter of Worship: 7 Words of Praise

Worship is fundamental to the people of God. Throughout the Old Testament, the Israelites were expected to worship God. The Psalms were a vital part of that worship. Thousands of years later, our primary goal should be to declare the worthiness of Christ! The words we commonly translate as praise, have a variety of meanings throughout the Bible. We will use these words and their meanings to empower our ability to draw near to and worship our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ throughout this winter of worship!

The Hands of Praise- Yadah (yaw-daw'): To revere or worship with extended hands. To hold out the hands. To throw a stone or an arrow.

Psalms 28.2, Psalm 44. 8, Psalm 67. 3, Psalm 88.9, Psalm 134. 2, Psalm 143. 6, Psalm 145. 10

The Fools of Praise- Halal (haw-lal'): To boast. To rave. To shine. To celebrate. To be clamorously foolish.

Psalms 22.22, Psalm 30. 11, Psalm 69. 30, Psalm 109. 30, Psalm 149.3, Psalm 150. 6

The Music of Praise- Zamar (zaw-mar'): To make music. To celebrate in song and music. To touch the strings or parts of a musical instrument.

Psalms 7. 7, Psalm 33. 1- 4, Psalm 57. 7, Psalm 101. 1, Psalm 144. 9, Psalm 150. 4

The Expectation of Praise- Towdah (to-daw'): An extension of the hand. Thanksgiving. A confession. A sacrifice of praise. Thanksgiving for things not yet received. A choir of worshippers.

Psalms 20. 7, Psalm 50. 22-23, Psalm 56. 11-12, Psalm 88.9, Psalm 121. 1- 2, Psalm 141. 2

The Posture of Praise- Barak (baw-rak'): To kneel. To bless God (as an act of adoration). To praise. To salute. To thank.

Psalms 72. 11-15, Psalm 95. 6, Psalm 100. 4, Psalm 103. 1-2, 20-22, Revelation 7. 11

The Songs of Praise- Tehillah (the-hil-law'): Laudation. A hymn. A song of praise. A new song. A spontaneous song.

Psalms 22. 3, Psalm 33. 3, Psalm 40.3, Psalm 144. 9, Revelation 5. 9, Revelation 14. 3

The Shout of Praise- Shabach (shaw-bakh'): To address in a loud tone. To shout. To commend, glory and triumph.

Psalms 35. 27, Psalm 63. 1-4, Psalm 66. 1-2, Psalm 71. 23, Psalm 95. 1, Psalm 98. 4, Psalm 117. 1, Psalm 145. 4
