CHURCH CONFERENCE: A church conference is scheduled for Tuesday, May 25th at 7:00 p.m. All are welcome to attend; only members are permitted to vote. Here is the motion that was made at the March 23rd Ad Council meeting: *Motion to purchase the property at 74 McGillstown Road, Annville, PA 17003 from Ken and Kim Moyer at the price of \$195,000.* The church would pay \$70,000 as a down payment (\$20,000 from building, \$50,000 from CD) and closing costs from the CD to secure a \$125,000 mortgage. The church conference (congregational vote) must pass with a minimum of 2/3 approval from members present.
