Update on the 74 McGillstown Road Property: At the June Ad Council meeting, Ad Council discussed the congregational vote in May to proceed with the purchase of the 74 McGillstown Road property. At this time, the Finance Committee and Trustees are working on arranging with Ken and Kim Moyer a closing date by August 31. The Finance Committee is also working on arranging a loan agreement with a lender. Another update will be given once the property transfer occurs.
