**FAMILY FELLOWSHIP NIGHT - HYMN SING:** Come and join in an Old-Fashioned Hymn Sing – Gaither Style – this evening at 7:00 p.m. at the church. This is a great time to worship together in song.

**The Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Service (LIRS)** is a nonprofit helping to resettle Afghan allies and refugees. As the U.S. government evacuates thousands from Kabul, LIRS expects an increased need for community support. LIRS president and CEO: *“If you have room in your heart to help these families start over from scratch, now is the time to make a difference.”*

Pastor Robb has indicated we might be able to assist with setting up apartments or driving refugees from the airport to new homes. He and Dee have also indicated they would be willing to host a family or an unaccompanied minor in their home. **OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD SHOE BOXES:** It’s time to start shopping for items to back in a shoe box to bless a child this year. While our church is not doing a collective packing party, we would still encourage you to pack your own shoe boxes. Ono UMC will again be a relay center for shoe box collections. Sunday, November 14<sup>th</sup> will be collection day. That is only 9 weeks away!

**UPDATE ON 74 MCGILLSTOWN RD PROPERTY:** At the June Ad Council meeting, Ad Council discussed the congregational vote in May to proceed with the purchase of the 74 McGillstown Road property. At this time, the Finance Committee and Trustees are working on arranging with Ken and Kim Moyer a closing date, upon completion of the appraisal. The Finance Committee has arranged a loan agreement with JBT. An update will be given once the property transfer occurs. If you are led to help pay down the mortgage on 74 McGillstown Road, please write “74 McGillstown” on the memo line of your check. If giving cash, put the cash in an envelope clearly labeled “74 McGillstown” If giving online, type “74 McGillstown” in the box. This way, all money given to reduce the mortgage can be accurately recorded and directed.

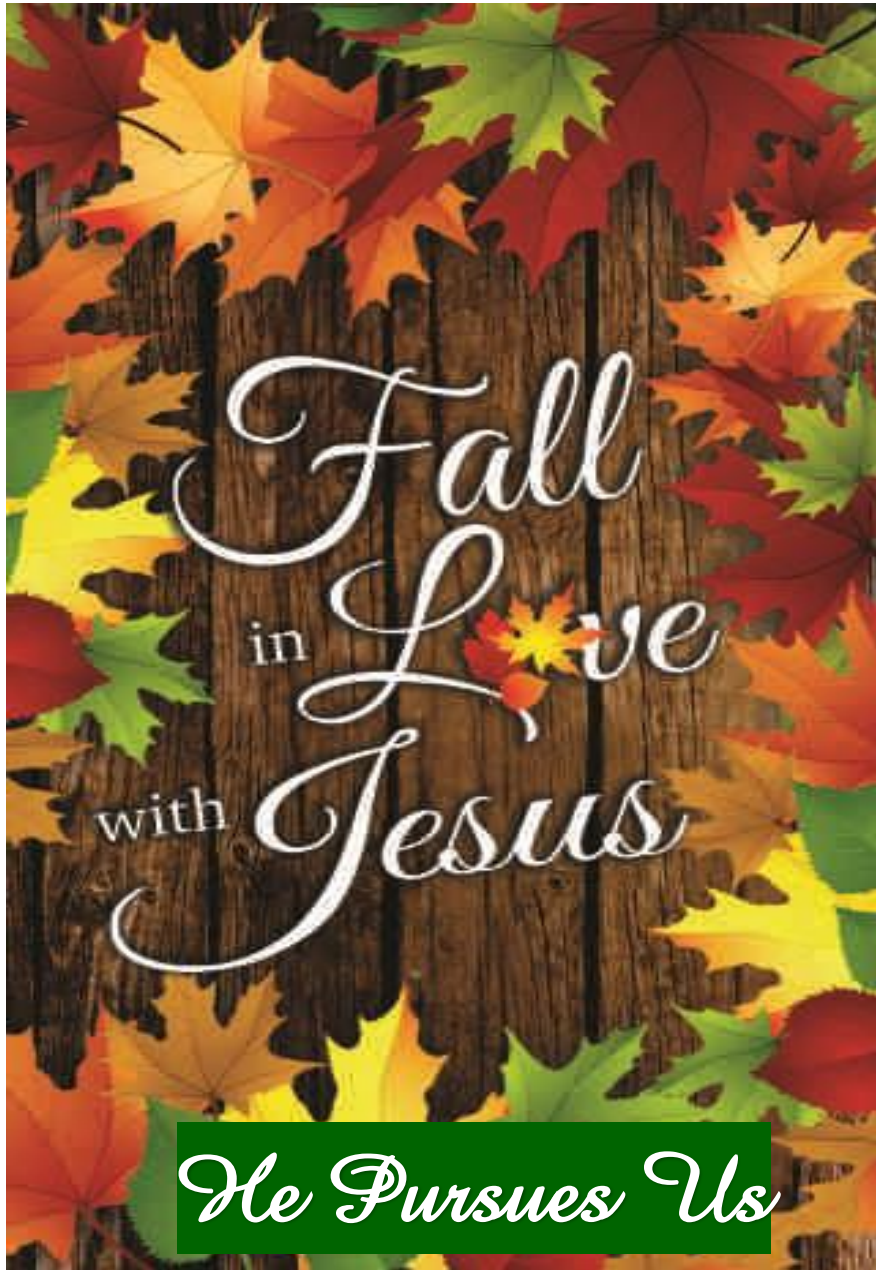
