
FREE FOOD BOX GIVE-A-WAY – October 23rd at Jonestown UMC, 1 p.m., while supplies last.

update on 74 McGillstown RD PROPERTY: At the June Ad Council meeting, Ad Council discussed the congregational vote in May to proceed with the purchase of the 74 McGillstown Road property. The closing occurred on October 1st. The Finance Committee has arranged a loan agreement with JBT. If you are led to help pay down the mortgage on 74 McGillstown Road, please write "74 McGillstown" on the memo line of your check.
