Love should be shown without pretending. Hate evil and hold on to what is good. Love each other like the members of your family. Be the best at showing honor to each other. Don't hesitate to be enthusiastic—be on fire in the Spirit as you serve the Lord! Be happy in your hope, stand your ground when you're in trouble, and devote yourselves to prayer. Contribute to the needs of God's people, and welcome strangers into your home.

-Romans 12. 9- 13

Paul frequently reminds the Church that we need to devote ourselves to prayer. In most of his letters, he mentions his prayers for that Church or person. He tells us to pray without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5. 16). James reminds the Church how powerful the prayers of the righteous are (James 5. 16). Prayer was a natural part of the early Church and empowered them to grow in extraordinarily difficult circumstances. Throughout the month of November, we will be exploring how to pray using a technique referred to as A.C.T.S.

Adoration is a great way to start praying. At its simplest, it is acknowledging the greatness of God's presence. The Lord's prayer starts by reminding us that God is holyset apart from the rest of creation. We do not pray to an idol or an object. We pray to the Creator of all things. We implore the Sustainer of all life. We relish the ability to connect to our Redeemer.

Confession reminds us that we have faults and failures that need the grace of Jesus Christ. It also reminds us that we need to offer that grace to the people who have wronged or harmed us. We are told to confess our sins to each other (James 5. 16) as a part of our spiritual practices.

Thanksgiving is our time to be grateful for what God has done for us. Paul reminds us to be thankful in all things (1 Thessalonians 5. 16). We are called to have an attitude of gratitude because everything we have comes from God. It is important to make sure that we are full of thanks to God.

Supplication is our asking God to intervene in different life circumstances. We want God to heal people, restore relationships, and so much more. We trust that God still operates in our world and performs miracles. Therefore, we intercede in prayer for those around us. I hope that as we dive into these concepts and seek to strengthen our prayer lives that God's presence will be revealed at an even greater level as we enter the holiday season of Thanksgiving, Christmas, and the New Year!




This is a short version of the sweet devotion Jess shared with us at the Moyer Hay Ride. We hope you enjoy it as much as we did!
