Answered Prayers in a Shoebox:

"When we have the Money." That's what Kwale's parents reminded him whenever the barefoot 13-year-old asked for a pair of shoes. Stepping on a thorn wasn't as painful to the Tanzanian boy as being looked down upon by his classmates and teachers for being poor. The teen considered begging or stealing to get a pair of shoes. But one Sunday when he went to church with his mother, there was an Operation Christmas Child event where children received a gift-filled shoebox. What was inside Kwale's shoebox? A variety of gifts including a pair of shoes that were exactly his size.

Look for the Giving Tree on Sunday, November 13th. Through the Giving Tree you have the opportunity to bless an at-risk child or teen through Lebanon County Children and Youth Services.

1. *Select a Tag -There will be suggestions for gifts on the tag. Please do not buy everything on the tag. There are sometimes multiple children from the same household and we would like the gift amounts to have a balance among the families.*
 2. *Wrap Your Gift-Securly attach the tag to your gift. If there is more than one package with your tag#, please put the tag # on each package and secure the gifts together or place in a large gift bag.*
 3. *Bring the gift back to the church by Dec 11th.*
