

Ad Council Minutes for November 15, 2022

Call to order by Kim Moyer and had opening prayer.

Pastor Robb did a short devotional on prayer. Read from James 5.

Review of last meeting minutes from Sept 27, 2022 – Jess Miller' name was incorrect on the minutes in the attendance – It had her maiden name (Yordy) – Eric Wentling moved to approve – Larry Richard 2nd – Voted by council...Approved.

Review of submitted reports

Treasurer Report – Rick Rollman – mentioned that names of signers need changed and updated with JBT. They do not have a budget for next year yet at this time...Rhoda Lauver was in Italy and was unavailable for a few weeks so they will be working on it in the near future and will have it to present at the next meeting. He did mention that we are currently not expecting to bring in enough income for the year to meet budget for this year. Dennis Grubb moved – Jared George 2nd – Approved

Jared George and Pastor Robb updated us on the furnace change over to propane from oil. We are still waiting for the part to make the conversion complete. Until then we need to keep resetting the furnace if it shuts down.

Bob Adams was added as a trustee and Cindy Myer was added as an Ad council member. These names need to be approved by council. Motion came from Nominations – the council voted and these names were approved.

Wildly Important Goal - Pastor Robb suggested that we move forward with small groups being our W.I.G. – He proposed that the staff be given a percentage of the worshipping congregation to be active in a small group. He proposed 2/3. If an optimal size is 8-10 people, Ono Church would need about 10 - 14. A small group is a group that meets for the spiritual growth of one another on a regular, longer term basis. How the group operates and who is involved in the group is up to the group. So a bible study is not necessarily a small group, a committee is not a small group... Pastor Robb is asking the council if they are onboard with moving forward with this goal? And if so, what is the next step? It is too big for the council to handle in a big group...staff would take the goal and break in to down to move toward the overall goal with things like leadership, felt needs, timing, etc. Larry Richard moved that small groups be our W.I.G. and Eric Wentling seconded...the council voted – Approved.

Pastor Robb is proposing we restructure how the church is functioning. He said most groups fall under two umbrellas – Outreach and Nurturing (In-reach) in addition to standard heads trustee, SPR, Finance, Lay Leadership, Lay Leader and church council. This group of heads would meet once a month to support and provide overall vision and the groups falling underneath each head would report prior to the headship meeting. This would hopefully produce a steady flow of information for better

communication and follow through church wide. Pastor Robb is asking council for permission to move forward with this idea and fill the position of Outreach and Nurturing (In- reach). Jared George moved and Jane Emrich 2nd -that Lay Leadership should fill outreach and Nurturing (In Reach) heads. Council voted – approved.

Yearly Calendar – was reviewed

Added Egg hunt – April 8th 10am

Motioned to approve the calendar by Eric Wentling – Loretta Longenecker 2nd – voted on and approved.

Kim Moyer asked council if we need to meet in December for budget meeting? Council voted no – it can wait until January 24, 2022. The church staff will provide dinner before the meeting to council at 6pm.
