*A **BIG Thank You to Tanya High** for sharing her time and artistic talents with us. Take a look in the main hallway to see the window art creations.*

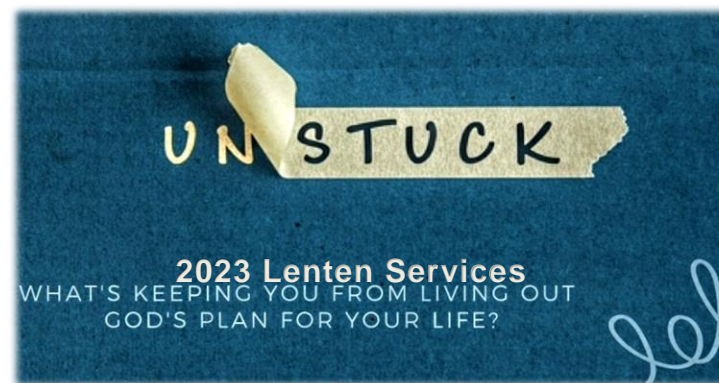
