**OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD:** Since 1993, Samaritan's Purse has delivered more than 209 million Operation Christmas Child shoebox gifts to boys and girls in over 170 countries and territories. Each one is a tangible expression of God's love to a child in need. Many of the children who receive these prayerfully packed gifts have never heard the Name of Jesus Christ. Some live in city slums while others are in isolated communities. Staff and local partners have used sailboats, canoes, motorcycles, ox carts, and even camels to get these special gifts into the hands of boys and girls waiting to hear about Jesus.

You only have 2 weeks to prepare your gifts and bring to church on collection Sunday – November 12<sup>th</sup>. Boxes and labels are in the narthex. Remember to pray for the child.

- 2. Wrap Your Gift-Securely attach the tag to your gift. If there is more than one package with your tag#, please put the tag # on each package and secure the gifts together or place in a large gift bag.*
