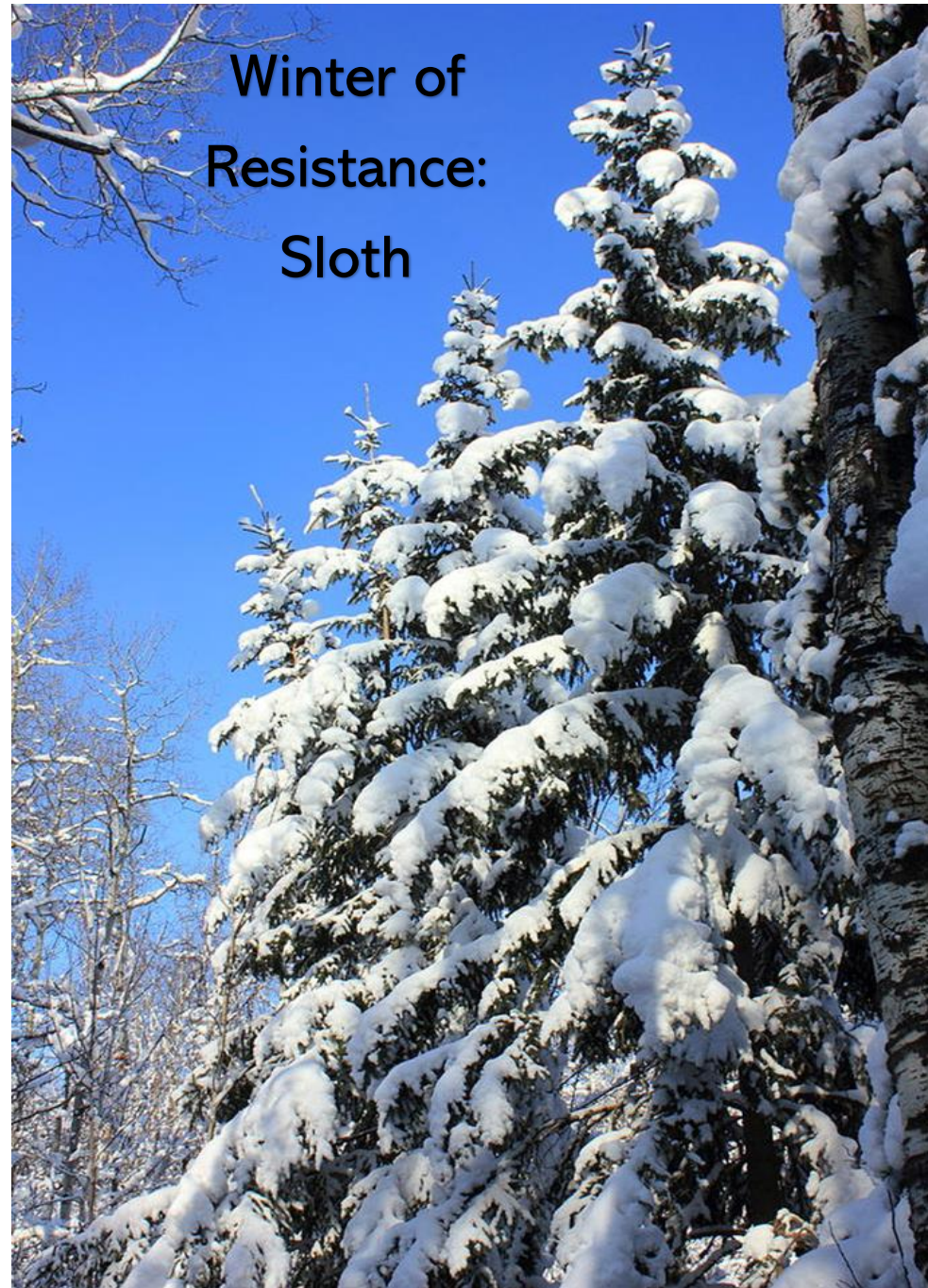
The Grand Opening will be held on Saturday February 24 at 1:00, with Pastor Robb E. Faller cutting the ribbon. County Commissioner, JoEllen Litz and the Mayor of Jonestown as well as Tim Laubach from IU13 will be there. The IU13 is now housed in the rest of this building. At this time the public will be able to visit the closet rooms.

The first Tuesday of each month between 4 and 6 pm is scheduled for dropping off clean, gently used clothing and shoes. Please note that the clothing is to be separate by size as much as possible. The clothing closet is also accepting hangers. NO WIRE HANGERS PLEASE. Also, NO HOUSEHOLD ITEMS.

The first official shopping days are scheduled for Tuesday February 27 from 10 AM – 12 NOON and Thursday February 29 from 4-6 PM. These days and times coincide with the day and times that JOY Food Pantry is open and operating for the convenience of the clients. Shopping days and times will be posted on the sign outside the entrance of the building.
